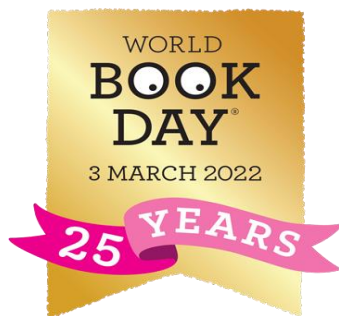

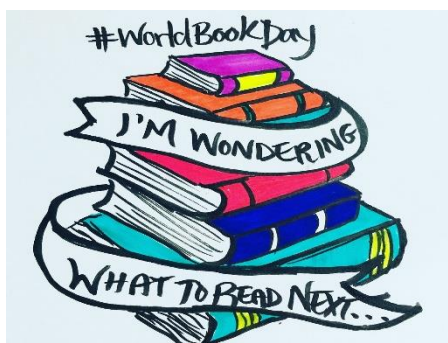
This year we are asking the children to come to school dressed as their favourite character from a book. The day will be devoted to reading for pleasure.
